This year, AP exams will be given during the weeks of May 6th - 10th and May 13th-17th. AP exams are \$94.00 each, which includes a \$15.00 nonrefundable deposit. Payment for these exams is due no later than **Wednesday, March 20th**. You may pay by cash or check and all **payments should be turned in to Ms. David and Ms. Salmon in the Library**. Checks should be made payable to Cooper High School.

Students who are eligible for free/reduced lunch and are coded as such in Infinite Campus will not pay a fee for the exam.
