

PBIS Tier 2 and 3 Referral



Purpose of the Tier 2 & 3 Team

To address the behavioral and mental health needs of students who require additional support beyond Tier 1

Criteria for Referral (One or More of the Following Apply to Student):

- Student has a diagnosis which has a negative impact on social/emotional functioning in the classroom
- Student has a history of trauma or a family situation that impacts social/emotional functioning in the school setting
- Student has two major or multiple minor referrals for behavior
- Student has attendance concerns (missing 10% of school days or more)
- Student has scored “at-risk” on SEL screenings (i.e. Resiliency Poll, Panorama) and intervention is needed
- Student is referred by parent or teacher due to internalized behavior (e.g. anxiety, depression) and intervention is needed

When a Referral is Made....

- A PBIS team meeting is scheduled and invites are sent in outlook.
- Members of the PBIS team include the teacher, a special education teacher, a counselor, assistant principal, school psychologist and other staff as appropriate (e.g. FRC Coordinator, school nurse, North Key).
- At the meeting, the team discusses concerns and makes a plan for intervention.
- After a designated period of time, the team meets back for follow-up.
