*PRIOR TO THE EVENT, a student may be allowed up to 10 days per school year to participate in an educational enhancement opportunity that the Principal determines to be of significant educational value. Participation in an educational foreign exchange program or intensive instructional program in one or more of the core curriculum subjects of English, Science, Math, Social Studies, Foreign Language or the Arts could be considered an Educational Enhancement Opportunity days.

In granting these EHO's, the principal must determine, and be prepared to defend to the state if audited, that the opportunity was of great enhancement that was equal to the education offered at Mann. In order for the principal to be able to justify and defend the EHO, she requests that the parent/student provide:

- a plan denoting the activities that will take place during the absence must be turned in with this form
- the plan should include age/grade appropriate activities correlated to school/Math and Reading must be included.
- students will complete a daily journal/log of activities turned in the day of return
- the type of trip and plan will help the principal to determine what other items she would need in order to meet the requirement of an EHO being of a significant educational value
