In Library, students will finish sharing their Natural Disaster news report projects. They will also review elements of poetry and various styles of poetry, while writing some original poems of their own.

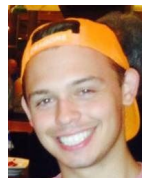


In Stem Lab, 4th grade will be learning about how light reacts when hitting different objects, and be generating models to illustrate how light enters the eye and travels to our brain!
