As we begin our ninth rotation of the Unified Arts schedule, we are working on lots of different and exciting concepts!



In Physical Education, 3rd grade students will be learning about Heart Disease and what contributes to it. They will take part in activities that improve heart health like circuit training, yoga, and cooperative games.

In Library, 3rd grade students will complete their PBL/Service Learning project learning about how the environment and available resources impact the culture of people in Africa (specifically, Kibera slum in Nairobi, Kenya). They will also learn about various styles of poetry and create some original poems.

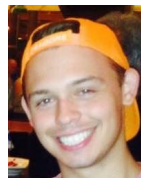
